Our hometown Harrisburg Senators, a farm team of the Washington Nationals, will be playing the Hartford Yard Goats, affiliated with the Colorado Rockies. We have reserved a number of umbrella-shaded tables overlooking the field along the third-base line. There will be all-you-can-eat hamburgers, hot dogs, barbecue chicken, baked beans, macaroni and cheese, coleslaw,

potato chips, cookies, soda and water. And best of all, an opportunity to relax and spend a pleasant afternoon with good friends.

Last year, we had the added treat of watching Pastor Tom Sweet throw out the first ball. This year, our sanctuary choir, led by Minister of Music Tyler Canonico, will open the game with the singing of the national anthem.
